Understanding Stress

- **Definition:** Anything that causes a change in your daily routine or personal life positive or negative.
- Examples:
 - Typical life events or transitions
 - Unexpected events
 - o Individual factors: e.g., substance use, health challenges
 - o Social factors: e.g., family or relationship issues
 - o Environmental or community factors: e.g., poverty, racism, natural disasters

The Stressed Brain

- **Stress vs. Chronic Stress:** Elevated cortisol levels can damage white matter (myelin sheath).
- Fear Response:
 - More easily triggered
 - Harder to return to a sense of safety and calm
- Overactivated Stress System:
 - Imbalance between the sympathetic ("fight or flight") and parasympathetic ("rest and digest") nervous systems

Effects of Stress

- The brain adapts to survival mode, limiting higher-level thinking and functioning.
- Usual coping strategies may stop working.
- Narrowed window of tolerance less ability to manage stress effectively.
- Greater risk for impulsive or risky behaviors.
- Difficult to help children co-regulate when we ourselves are dysregulated.

Grounding Techniques

- Focused breathing (4–4–4 or 6–6–6 pattern)
- Humming or singing
- Yawning
- Visualization (colors, images, sounds)
- Self-hug or "butterfly tapping"
- Bilateral stimulation
- Picture someone you love

Blocked Care & Blocked Trust

Based on Dr. Dan Hughes & Jonathan Baylin — Book: "Brain-Based Parenting: The Neuroscience of Caregiving for Healthy Attachment"

- Feeling stuck in survival mode
- Emotional disengagement or numbness
- Decreased empathy and compassion
- · Apathy toward the child

- Focusing only on behaviors instead of their meaning
- Viewing behaviors as bad or selfish rather than expressions of need

Responding to Stress

- How we respond matters most.
- **Resilience:** The ability to manage stress and function well when faced with adversity, trauma, or change.
- Parental Resilience Includes:
 - Effective problem-solving
 - Healthy coping strategies
 - Consistent self-care
 - Willingness to seek support
 - Accessing mental health or substance-use services when needed
 - Preventing stress from negatively impacting parenting

Minimizing the Chaos

Reduce Decision Fatigue

- Use meal kits or grocery delivery
- · Plan meals ahead of time
- Create consistent morning and bedtime routines
- Delegate non-essential decisions
- Make tough decisions earlier in the day
- Turn off unnecessary notifications
- · Ask others for input when needed

Keep Schedules Visible

- Coordinate multiple family schedules
- Consider who needs access and how to keep updates current
- Choose the right format: paper planner, family whiteboard, or digital calendar

Organizing Paperwork

Common Documents:

- Placement or court paperwork
- School/daycare forms
- Medical records
- Contact and visitation logs
- Service provider information
- Reimbursement forms and blank templates

Organization Options:

- Binder system (for medically complex children):
 - Keep forms and a monthly visit calendar in front pocket
 - Tabs for: Placement, Legal, School, Medical (Primary, Specialists, RCOC, Hospital), and Blank Forms
- Digital system:
 - Google Docs for contact logs
 - Google Calendar for appointments

Self-Care Strategies

Do what brings you joy and calm:

- Window shopping
- Reading or journaling
- Listening to music or podcasts
- Spending time outdoors
- Cooking a favorite meal
- Yoga, stretching, or meditation (try YouTube sessions)
- Writing a "ta-da" list (accomplishments, not tasks)
- Napping
- Dancing or singing
- o Dressing in a way that feels good
- Acts of kindness for others
- Talking with a friend
- Enjoying a warm drink
- Rewatching a favorite show or movie
- Hugging a loved one
- Planning a pretend or future vacation

Remember: Not Everything Has to Get Done

- Chores and errands can wait.
- Your relationship with your child is more important than a perfect to-do list.
- Focus on what's truly necessary or urgent.
- It's okay to ask for help.
- Prioritize rest sleep is a form of self-care.

Celebrate the Good

- Be present to notice moments of joy and connection.
- Laugh, smile, and share small moments music, meals, cuddles.
- Celebrate your child's accomplishments, milestones, and interests.
- Create new "firsts" and family traditions.
- **Start small** plan simple family activities or game nights.
